Budget


The budget must be submitted for approval at the October meeting. If you have any suggestions for changes in the budget please contact an officer after the election.

Newport News is very strict about not plugging in batteries until you are in the flight station area. Electric engines can be very dangerous if they power up when the plane is not properly secured. Radios should be programmed with a throttle cut off switch. This is best practice and should be followed out at our field as well. Make sure that your plane is properly restrained prior to powering up. If possible, use an arming plug on larger electric planes.
