

This month's website of the month was submitted by Dave Craft (Thanks Dave!) and is called RCSCALEBUILDER.COM. From their website: "RCSCALEBUILDER.COM started as an idea in the year 2002 at the Rally of Eagles event while I was socializing with other modelers one evening. We all agreed it would be great to have our own community to share ideas and techniques, allow folks new in this aspect of the hobby get help when they needed to ask questions, communicate with designers, kit manufactures, other vendors, and most importantly to help inject a little life back into R/C Scale Modeling. Even with the

other sites on the internet there was no true focus on scale building. So I decided to take on the challenge. With the advice of fellow modelers, I created the first version of RCSCALEBUILDER.COM and officially launched it June 2003 running on a small server hosted by a friend that ran a local ISP.
